and kitchen appliances, vintage toys, and old-fashioned coal generator.

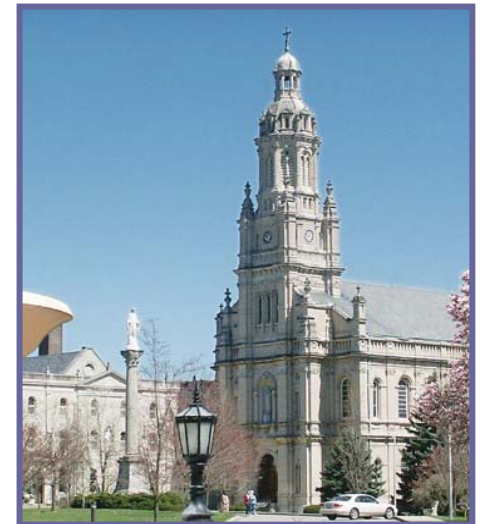


Many museum goers favor the train room where you can see a

Take a step back into the past in "Covered Bridge Country" for a **candlelight dinner** on the beautiful 1888 landscaped covered bridge that sets over the upper Cataract Falls. Guided tour includes:

Indoor and outdoor tour of the beautiful Italian Renaissance-style church, The Church of the Immaculate Conception; Heritage Museum; National Shrine of Our Lady of Providence; National Shrine of Saint Mother Theodore Guerin; the 162-year-old St. Anne Shell Chapel; historical places associated with Mother Theodore's early mission; the alpaca herd; horses; power and water plants; woods and grounds, etc.

Additional touring options:

Old Jail Museum

An old rotary jail built in 1882, the **only one left which is still in operating** condition, now houses a museum about the history of the jail itself.



The system of a rotating turntable of cells seemed to make sense as the GUIDE shares with us this unique architectural landmark, along with the sheriff's residence.

Home of Ben-Hur - Lew Wallace Guided tour of home and museum.

Built over a period of 3 years 1895-1898, the building now houses artifacts and memorabilia from the lifetime of General Lew Wallace who authored *Ben Hur: A Tale of the Christ*.

Located in the private study of Major General Lew Wallace, author of *Ben-Hur*, the museum contains items collected by Wallace during his life as an author, soldier, statesman, artist, violinist, and inventor.
