### LOOK, SEE and LISTEN -

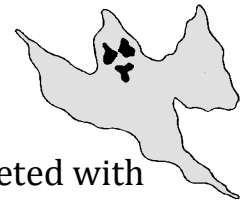
Enjoy a **driving tour** with a

historic Putnam district.

A stop will be made at the  
**STONE ACADEMY.** Started in 1809  
when it was built as a state house,  
continued as a court, a school, a  
church, and became a stop on the  
historic Underground Railroad.  
There was even an actress who lived  
in the house in the 1870s.

Board the **St. Helena III** for a **night time cruise** on the historic Ohio Erie Canal. Lantern light will guide the team of horses as you are pulled down the Ohio Erie Canal while listening to ghostly tales and haunted history.

### Warehouse on the Canal

We strongly recommend that you come out and experience this piece of history for yourself.

Built around the turn of the century, the basement was used as a funeral home and mortuary in the 1920s and 1930s. During the plague of the 1910 era, dozens of bodies were piled up in the basement area due to the over whelming death rate.

Do the canal workers still stroll the towpath of the Ohio & Erie Canal?

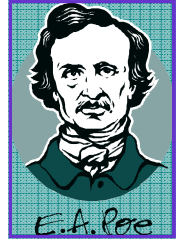
