**Guided tour of Pyramid**

**Hill**—one of a few sculpture parks in the United States. **Touted as the "most beautiful natural setting of any art park in the country"** by Atlantic Monthly. With 265 acres, 7 lakes, gardens and 50 sculptures.



**Tour the NEW Ancient Sculpture Museum**

located on the grounds of Pyramid Hill, this \$3.5 million building is modeled after an ancient villa, with sculptures from **ancient** Egypt, Italy, Greece and Mesopotamia.

**Enjoy desserts at the Fitton Center—**

contemporary displays by artists of all ages and abilities. Three galleries present high quality exhibitions in an exciting variety of media and content.

**Tour The Verdin Bell and Clock Museum**

North America's oldest bell and clock company, located in historic St. Paul's Church. The rich beauty of the vaulted ceilings, stained glass windows, hand-painted murals, marble, and terrazzo flooring is a perfect setting for the antique clocks, bells and bell-ringing equipment that tell the story of a **unique Cincinnati business.**

A guided tour of the

**Cathedral Basilica of the Assumption—**

copied from Notre Dame in Paris, over 100 years ago. The Cathedral has **82 stained glass windows**, including **the largest in the world.** One of only 31 Basilicas in the country, and is considered the most beautiful.

Take a **docent** lead tour of the

**Cincinnati Art Museum**—an art collection of more than 60,000 works spanning 6,000 years. This is the largest art museum in Ohio and the area's most treasured cultural asset.

**Guided behind the scenes tour**

**of Music Hall**—an acoustically perfect auditorium and a masterpiece of High Victorian Gothic Revival architecture, with an appropriately Germanic Flavor. Music Hall is the grand dame of Cincinnati's arts venues and is the home of the Cincinnati Symphony Orchestra, Cincinnati Pops Orchestra and May Festival.

**The Taft Museum** (built in the 1800's, and once owned by the half-brother of President William Howard Taft) houses the Taft's love for art and European masterpieces.
